ATTACHED. TREBLE HOOKS ARE NOT LEGAL GEAR.  
(EXCLUDING DRIFT OR SET NETS, BEACH SEINES, POLE  
GAFFS, RING NETS AND EXPLOSIVES) AS PER THE  
SKOKOMISH FISHING ORDINANCE SECTION 7.02.084.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: 1) ALL FISH POSSESSED BY A FISHER MUST BE AT  
LEAST 12 INCHES IN LENGTH.  
2) DAILY CATCH LIMIT OF 5 FISH PER FISHER.  
3) ALL STEELHEAD AND OTHER SALMON MUST BE RELEASED  
INTO THE CREEK UNHARMED, UNLESS THEIR CAPTURE  
IS PERMITTED BY OTHER TRIBAL REGULATION.  
4) ALL FISHERS MUST HAVE A TRIBAL SUBSISTENCE CARD  
IN THEIR POSSESSION.

JUSTIFICATIONS: PROVIDE A SUBSISTENCE FISHERY FOR THE HARVEST OF  
AVAILABLE ANADROMOUS TROUT SPECIES.
